Less than an hour from Pittsburgh's "Golden Triangle", Donegal Highlands is the course visible from the eastbound lane of the PA turnpike just prior to exit #91. From the Donegal exit (#91), turn right onto Route 31 west and proceed approximately 1.5 miles to Clay Pike. Turn right and continue 250 yards to the entrance on your left.
